MOTION TO INTERVENE OR, IN THE ALTERNATIVE, TO PARTICIPATE AS AMICUS **CURIAE**

Applicant Defendant-Intervenors Idaho Farm Bureau Federation, Wyoming Farm Bureau, Montana Farm Bureau Federation, Washington Farm Bureau, Idaho State Snowmobile Association, Colorado Snowmobile Association, and Colorado Off-Highway Vehicle Coalition hereby move to intervene as of right in this case pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 24(a). Should this Court deny Applicants permission to intervene in any form, Applicants move to be admitted as amicus curiae.

Pursuant to Local Rule 7.1(c)(1), counsel for all parties were previously notified of Applicants' intent to file this Motion to Intervene.
