**ORDER GRANTING JOINT  
MOTION TO DISMISS**

On March 12, 2024, Plaintiff Californians for Equal Rights Foundation filed a complaint against Defendants City of San Diego (the “City”), Housing Authority of the City of San Diego (“Housing Authority”), and San Diego Housing Commission (“Housing Commission”), alleging one claim for violation of the Equal Protection Clause of the Fourteenth Amendment. Doc. No. 1. On July 9, 2024, the Court granted the parties Joint Motion to Dismiss the City and Housing Authority. Doc. Nos. 27, 29.


The remaining parties, Plaintiff and the Housing Commission, have since filed a stipulation and joint motion to dismiss pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure

1 41(a)(1)(A)(ii). Doc. No. 56. According to the filing, the parties have agreed to dismiss  
2 this action with prejudice, each party to bear its own costs. *Id.* at 2–3.

3 Upon due consideration, good cause appearing, the Court **GRANTS** the joint  
4 motion and **DISMISSES** this action in its entirety with prejudice. Each party shall bear  
5 its own costs and attorneys’ fees. The Court further **DIRECTS** the Clerk of Court to  
6 terminate all pending deadlines and hearings and close this case.
