GREETINGS:

The following action was taken by the Arizona Supreme Court on November 4, 2025, regarding the above-referenced cause:

ORDERED: Petition for Review of Special Action Decision of the Court of Appeals = GRANTED as to the following rephrased issue:

Whether a jury trial in superior court is required under the Arizona Constitution, article II, § 23, in cases initiated by the Arizona Corporation Commission where a jury demand is made by a Commission enforcement target.

FURTHER ORDERED: The case shall be set for oral argument.

FURTHER ORDERED: The parties may file simultaneous supplemental briefs, not to exceed 20 pages in length, no later than November 24, 2025. Any amicus briefs are due on or before December 9, 2025, and any responses to amicus briefs are due on or before December 29, 2025. Any amicus briefs or responses may not exceed 20 pages in length.

FURTHER ORDERED: Request for Attorneys' Fees (Petitioners EFG, et al.) = CONTINUED.

Filing a supplemental brief is permissive rather than mandatory. This order is not an invitation to repeat the contents of the Petition for Review, the Response, or any Reply. Lack of a supplemental brief is not an admission that the opposing party or parties' position should prevail.

All supplemental briefs shall include a table of citations that alphabetically arranges and indexes the cases, statutes and other authorities cited in the brief and refers to the pages of the brief on which each citation of authority appears.

The Clerk of the Court of Appeals, Division One, Phoenix, must forward the remaining record to the Clerk of the Supreme Court.

Counsel will be advised of the oral argument date and time when the hearing date is determined.
